CDC examined the grant proposal from the Cape Cod Presbyterian Fellowship, the Rev. Alonso DaCunha, total \$ 21,000.00, equal to \$ 1,750.00 a month, but it was not voted, due to the fact that we are in transition as part of the Nurturing Committee. Yet, the Presbytery included that amount as a permanent budget.

This congregation is mostly Brazilian, and it has been steadily and consistently turning into a multicultural congregation, including the second generation of immigrants born in the USA. The children and teenagers baptized in 2018 have been regularly attending worship and Sunday school, along with their parents, which is good progress towards its future organization as a congregation.

Last year their attendance grew up to the point that they rent the sanctuary of the Federated Church in Hyannis, to accommodate their group for worship.
