

EXIT INTERVIEWS

The Exit Interview is arranged by the COM Co-Chairs.

The preference is for the Exit Interview to take place in person, but if that is not possible, video-conferencing can be done.

Suggested questions for the interview:

1. What are some of the joys of your ministry in this place?
2. As you look back on your ministry here, how has the community of faith that called you changed?
3. And how have you changed?
4. What, in your opinion, are the major issues/challenges/weaknesses facing the church (or other institution) as you leave?
5. What have been your major frustrations in the course of your ministry here?
6. What are the two or three things you would like to say to your successor in this position?
7. Is there anything you would like to say about your experience as a member of Presbytery of Southern New England?

The interview team will select a clerk to submit a written report to the Committee on Ministry.
