## **Parish Associate Relationship**

A Parish Associate is a teaching elder who serves in some validated ministry other than a congregation, is a member-at-large, or is retired, but who wishes to maintain a relationship with a particular congregation in keeping with ordination to the office of teaching elder. Such persons, already qualified as continuing members of the Presbytery of Southern New England, may serve as Parish Associates. The relation shall be established, upon nomination by the Pastor, between the Parish Associate, the Session, and the Presbytery. The Parish Associate shall be responsible to the Pastor, as head of staff, on an "as needed, as available" basis and with or without remuneration.
