Thank you to those who completed the questionnaire sent in early December where we reported to you the status of church per capita payments 2023, 2024 and 2025. For those of you who have yet to respond, there's still time to do so using this [LINK](#).

We also wanted to communicate your **per capita assessment for 2026**. On the second page of this letter [or attached] is a spreadsheet by church showing what that number is and what quarterly or monthly payments would be. If you let us know your preferred invoicing frequency, you will receive an electronic invoice within a day or two. You may also feel free to use this as your first invoice to begin your remittance process.

Also attached or included is **2026 PSNE Remittance Form** for PSNE Per Capita and Mission with instructions for Special Offerings and other "Pass Through" Mission Giving. As you may recall, **PSNE is no longer accepting "pass-through" payments for Churchwide offerings**. Instead, please forward all Special Offerings to GA and Synod as noted on the remittance form. We appreciate your assistance in making this shift as it reduces the time required to track and forward these gifts.

Finally, **significant changes were made to Churchwide Special Offerings**. You can read more about it [HERE](#), but the main difference is that there are now three instead of four and one has a new name. Please also see this [Calendar for Special Offerings](#) as you consider which ones to participate in this year.
