Items listed on the **Information Docket** are considered reported to the Presbytery at the time of adjournment. The Information Docket includes all written reports that do not contain items for Presbytery action, including any Financial Reports provided in the meeting materials. Any person entitled to speak at this meeting may remove an item from the Information Docket for further reporting or discussion, until the docket is approved. No motion to receive reports is necessary.

The **Consent Motion** is intended for matters that are not controversial, and items are included in it only by unanimous consent. Any person entitled to vote at this meeting may ask that an item be removed from the Consent Motion when the Presbytery considers the Consent Motion. The Presbytery will debate and act on those items during the relevant committee report. The Consent Motion will be adopted by a vote.

Consent Motion

1. That the Presbytery approve the minutes of the 202nd Stated Meeting on February 10, 2026.
2. That the Presbytery grant excuses from attendance at the 203rd Stated Meeting to those needing the same, but that the Presbytery suspend the reading of their names.
3. That the Presbytery seat as Corresponding Members those ministers for whom an introduction is made at the beginning of the meeting.
4. That the Presbytery appoint the Rev. Dr. Shannan Vance-Ocampo as Overture Advocate to the 227th General Assembly for [OVT-032], On Reinstating the Immigration Attorney Position
5. That the Presbytery authorize the Roundtable to appoint appropriate Overture Advocates to the 227th General Assembly for any or all of the other overtures with which PSNE has concurred.
